## **ADMISSION PROCESS**

Admissions for all classes, including preschool, primary, and secondary, are typically accepted once a year in March. Afer May 30, new admissions are only considered for transfer cases. Parents who wish to enroll their child are encouraged to register for an admission test by completing the admission orm at the school office and receiving an appointment card for the test and interview. However, registraration alone does not ensure admission. Admission is contin ent on successfully passing the admission test, interview, and seat availability.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 4. The parents or guardians must keep the school informed if they are facing any financial difficult in paying the fees.
- 5. The school may consider grantingan extension of the due date for payment of fees on a case-by-case basis, afer receiving a request from the parents or guardians.
