Examination Schedule:

AFSS provides a detailed examination schedule at the start of the academic year, aligning with the academic calendar for effective preparation.

Academic Year and Terms:

The year spans April to March, divided into two six-month terms:

- **First Term:** April to September
- **Second Term:** October to March

Assessment Components:

- First Term: Midterm exams, periodic tests, and classroom activities
